

Annual Report - 2022-23

On behalf of the members of
Mannam Memorial Higher Secondary School and
myself, I sincerely welcome you all
to this 52nd annual day celebrations. On
this joyful occasion, I take it as my
honour and privilege to present before
you a brief report of the functioning
of the school during the academic
year 2022-23.

Our school started functioning in 1971,
under the management of Nari Service
Society and has been named after a
great visionary and social reformer
Sri. Bharathakesari Mannath Padmanabham.
The school has been following his vision
of education which shaped thousands
of responsible citizens and is shining
in their respective fields.

This report exhibits the
achievements of our students which
made the school proud with their
brilliant efforts in both academic and

extra-curricular activities. We have been committed to create an environment to provide a platform for individual thinking and holistic development of the child's personality.

This academic year commenced on 1st June 2022 with 'Poaveshanotsavam' for the classes 1st std to XII with a team of around 520 students along with 28 faculty members and 10 non-teaching staffs. Now we are going to present 56 students from std X and 70 students from XI and 66 students from XII to attend the Public examinations March 2023. In the previous academic year 86 students from std X and 29 students from XII represented our school. Among them 11 students from 10th and 3 students from XII had secured A+ grade in all subjects. Also 4 students from Xth and got 9A+ and 1 student from XII had secured 5A+. Considering the number of students appeared, we have high percentage of A+ holders. I take this opportunity to congratulate all the winners, their leading guides and their parents behind this credible achievement.

Multifaceted activities are undertaken for the allround development of our children which helps them mentally and physically strong and active. Master Sreehari S. of std X B and Kumari Devika Rajesh of XII B were designated as Head Boy and Head Girl respectively.

In keeping with the School's policy of continuous and comprehensive evaluations, we have taken monthly tests, mid-term tests and terminal evaluations to improve and update the capabilities of the students. The outcome of these test is shared with the parents through the class PTAs and their guidance is also provided.

Various co-curricular activities are held under different clubs which provide a forum for the children to hold discussions and share knowledge related to academics. The tr. Co-ordinators of different clubs are Science club - Smt. Bindu. V.R, Maths club - Smt. Neena. K.L. S.S. Club - Smt Amitha.V, Red Cross - Smt. R. Latha, IT club - Smt Asha Abraham. They sincerely guide the students.

On 5th June Environment day was observed. The theme of this day 2022 is 'Only One Earth' highlighting the need to live sustainably in harmony with nature. Our students sang environmental songs and saplings were planted in the campus by our Principal, teachers and students.

To emphasize the importance of reading among students and to enrich the children for creative and innovative learning process, we observed 'Reading day' on 19th June. Our children actively participated in reading competitions.

The winners were awarded with prizes. Students and teachers are acquainted with books by famous authors each week through WhatsApp class groups.

To support the learners to ease their stress through 'yoga tips' 'yoga day' was observed on 21st June. On the same day 'Music day' was also celebrated. Special assembly was held on this occasion and many programmes were conducted along with mass drill.

On 23rd June Anti-Dengue rally was arranged by both Gandhidarsan club and Vrindabhanmission club. This rally was presided over by Sri. Sunil Kumar. S.P. Vrindabhanmission Dange office which helped the children to arouse a sense of awareness about the fallacies of using dengue and also helped to make them understand the dangers of dengue abuse. Smt - A.R. Jayasree is the convenor of Gandhidarsan club and Smt. Samthi snetha is the convenor of Vrindabhanmission club.

On July 1st Doctor's day was observed to honour the doctors for their contributions and noble service to society especially in the recent pandemic situations.

Malyalam club of our school organised the day of remembrance of

former malayalam novelist and legendary writer Vaikom Muhammad Basheer on 5th July. Photo exhibition and Commemoration speech regarding the same made it a memorable occasion. Smt - M. R. Rajasse is the Convenor of Malayalam club. Under the auspices of Sub-district Vidyarangam Kala Sahithya Vedi (Sangotsavam) was held at Govt U.P. School. One students participated in it and won prizes and also in P.T.B. Smarak Bala Shashtra Pareeksha one students secured prizes. Smt . L. By hoisting the national flag by one honorable Principal we proudly celebrated the independence day on 15th August. Various competitions like quiz, essay writing and patriotic song were organised prior to this day. Our children actively participated in these competitions and won medals. In connection with this day Kanaka Chandrasakha Muthicharla Dr. N. Radhakrishna gave an inspirational speech to students. ~~Dear~~ Dist. Co-ordinator Sri. To tap the leadership skills and teaching aptitude of students Talent Day was observed. One student hon. Paruppal handed over the symbolic key to the school administration to the student Principal Samja. S.S. of XII A and vice principal Akhil of XII B. The student teacher's presentation was the special highlight of the day which inspired them to build their moral character. Prizes were given to the best student teachers in a special assembly.

On Sep 20th School fair was held which helped the students to learn through experience where students compete to outshine others through reward based assessment.

A motivation class was organised on the topic 'life is beautiful' by Dr. V. R. Raji about the emotional problems among teenagers.

To inculcate the spirit of positive challenges and sportsmanship among the students and make them prepare for the life ahead, Sports competitions were organised. One children actively participated in different

Competitions and won certificates, medals and trophies. In the sub district sports Competitions, Pearson. P.s of XI B seemed 1st prize in Jaiyalintha and Sivaprasaneen XI B got 3rd prize in 5 km walking. On behalf of one school, I congratulate them on this occasion.

On oct 10th a motivation class on mental health led by Dr. Reghu Raghavan former student of our school, Faculty of Health and Life Sciences, De Montfort University - U.K. He was the former student of our School. The class was a good experience to students.
